We create a safe environment to discuss the sensitive issues surrounding this very common and prevalent problem in our violent and over-sexualized society. We teach how parents can create an emotionally safe and healthy home for children.

We also provide a resource center with materials teaching families how to protect themselves from abduction, and how to recognize and react to sick people that threaten our children's safety.

The children also attend a workshop where they meet the local Police Officers, check out the police cars, and learn safety tips in a fun and fear-free way.

Admission is free, and all children will receive a photo-fingerprint ID card.
